2005 ANNUAL TOUR OF HOMES SET FOR SEPTEMBER 17, 2005

The Board of Directors of the Historic Preservation Society of Social Circle, Inc., has announced their annual fundraising TOUR OF HOMES will be held on Saturday, September 17, 2005, in Social Circle, from 10:00AM until 4:00 PM featuring seven historic properties: Gunter Hall, 1855, the Society's Headquarters which the society purchased and moved to its current site in 1992; Mars Hill Baptist Church, 1884, is a fine example of church architecture during the late 19th Century; Gibbs – Herndon- Rogers-Bailes house, 1836; Catherine Gresham Townhouse, 1872 currently owned by Mr. and Mrs. Kenneth Dalton; Dr. Brown's Townhouse, the property of Mrs. Betty Lyon; Stanton-Studdard-Dupree House, owned by Mr. and Mrs. Michael Hornsby, and the Robinson-McDowell-Hollis House now the property of Mr. and Mrs. Morgan Hollis. A bonus for this years tour will be the Social Circle Theater just outside the City Limits, which was built by Mr. Bob Standridge in which non-professional citizens and other worthy persons could present historical stories, skits, musical programs, etc., for the edification of our citizens and visitors

Proceeds from this year's tour will be used for the continuing restoration and upkeep of Gunter Hall, with the next major focus to be landscaping and repairs.
